They are open 7 days a week and it is for any other recycle items.

TRASH/RECYCLE BIN PICK-UP SCHEDULE ON HOLIDAYS

The City of Port St Lucie website says the only holidays that affect the schedule are July 4th, Thanksgiving and Christmas. So far, if a holiday lands on a Thursday our pick up will occur the following day. With Christmas occurring on a Sunday this year it is unclear if that will have any affect on the pick-up day.
