THE POTENTIAL DANGER OF PARKING VIOLATIONS LIKE THESE



This photo was taken February 22nd on the 2500 side of Tropical East and was sent to the Board by a homeowner to the clubhouse email. This situation happens often in this section of the complex and must stop when it occurs anywhere in T.E. Extra vehicles, whether they are yours or a guest's, cannot be parked on the road day or night. The only exception would be a contractor vehicle during the day can park on the side of the road but it would be best if it's going to be an all-day project, such as roofs, that the owner parks their own vehicle at the clubhouse for the day.

The major danger involved with this illegal parking is that <u>emergency</u> <u>vehicles will not be able to get down the road</u>. If you need an ambulance or a fire truck, I'm sure you'd want them to get to you without delay.

In both the Clubhouse lot and rear parking area, overnight parking is for a short term basis with a permit on the dashboard. This applies to owners and visitors.

Consider this a reminder that illegally parked vehicles will result in the unit owner being asked to meet with the covenants committee where fines of \$100.00 per event may be issued. Vehicles at your home need to be in your own garage or fully in your driveway, Period.
