PARKING ON THE ROAD

ANNUAL HURRICANE TREE TRIMMING

In the next week the trimming of the trees in preparation for hurricane season will begin. It will probably take a few weeks to get it all done so if you have decorative items under the trees, you should probably put them somewhere else until the trees are done.

FINES BEING ISSUED FROM THE CITY OF PORT ST LUCIE

Evidently the city has decided to issue fines directly to residents who do not follow the restrictions for when you can put trash to the curb/driveway and how long the bins can sit there after they are emptied. The following info on the new ordinance was published in the TC Palm on April 19.

The notice says:

- Residents are required to take their garbage containers to the curb no earlier than 6 pm on the night before scheduled pickup days.
- Garbage bins aren't supposed to be left curbside more than 24 hours after scheduled pickups.
- Bulky waste items aren't supposed to be placed on curbs more than 24 hours ahead of scheduled pickup times.
- The ordinance authorizes the city to fine residents who violate the bin placement rules \$35 on a first offense and \$70 on subsequent offenses.
- Those who violate the bulk waste or yard waste rules can face fines of \$110 for a first offense then \$220 for subsequent offenses.
- The ordinance also authorizes city workers to clean up messes that are left in violation of the rules then bill the property owners for the expense. The cleanup charges called for in the ordinance are \$300 for first offenses and \$600.
